



CODE OF CONDUCT

We don't allow graphic images in the body of the March, in order to avoid disturbing the marchers. Anyone displaying graphic images must remain positioned directly behind the march and, to be clear, not within, on the periphery, or in front of the body of the march.

At the Legislature and Churchill Square, anyone displaying graphic imagery must not obstruct any onlooker's view of the speakers.

Any graphic images must remain situated behind the periphery of the observers which, it is important to remember, may vary.
